ITINERARY

[⁺]Friday, June 18, Day 1: DEPART USA

Depart Newark Airport on an overnight flight to Kraków, Poland. Enjoy dinner and a movie aboard the flight.

むSaturday, June 19, Day 2: KRAKÓW

Arrival in Kraków, where we are greeted by our English Speaking Tour Manager, who helps us with the transfer and hotel check-in. Settle into the hotel in the center of town. Stretch our legs on a walk to the center of Krakow. Tonight we have a welcome dinner at our hotel. Overnight in Krakow. (Welcome dinner with wine)

After breakfast, we have Divine Liturgy followed by a walking tour of Kraków city center, which is listed by UNESCO as one of the most significant historic sites in the world. We see all the highlights of the Old Town that made Kraków famous including the Royal Route, which goes along the beautiful streets of the Slowacki Theatre. We also see one of the oldest universities in Europe - Jagiellonian University, the spectacular central Market Square, and St. Mary´s Basilica. Climbing Wawel Hill to the Castle District we visit the Cathedral of Kraków which houses the Shrine of St. Stanislaus, the patron saint of Poland. In the afternoon, we visit the fascinating salt mines with its chapels made of salt. Overnight Kraków. (B, D)

¹ Onday, June 21, Day 4: DIVINE MERCY – AUSCHWITZ

This morning we travel to the nearby Shrine of Divine Mercy, where we see the rooms of St. Faustina and to the Have no Fear Center celebrating the life of St. John Paul II. Following lunch on our own, we visit Auschwitz, the Nazi concentration camp where St. Teresa Benedicta (Edith Stein) faced martyrdom, and St. Maximilian Kolbe died in the Death Block from starvation after volunteering his life for that of a fellow prisoner. Tonight to lift our spirits we have dinner in a local restaurant with a folklore show. Overnight Kraków. (B, Special Dinner)

Today, we drive to Częstochowa, the world-famous city for the Pauline monastery of Jasna Gora which is the home of the famous Black Madonna painting - a shrine of the Virgin Mary. Millions of pilgrims come to Częstochowa to see it every year. We join the tour and experience this religious and spiritual center of Poland. On the way back, we stop and visit Olsztyn, a small town 16 kilometers from Częstochowa with amazing ruins of a medieval castle. We follow the Eagle Nest Trail - a line of medieval fortifications beautifully situated on limestone cliffs. Overnight Kraków. (B, D)

We depart this morning to Slovakia with a stop in Litmanova village- wherein 1990, the Blessed Mother Mary appeared to two Byzantine Catholic school girls. We climb the mountain to the apparition site. Continue on to Prešov and visit St. John the Baptist Greek Catholic Cathedral with a tour of the Archeparchial museum and have an audience with Metropolitan Jan Babjak (TBC). Walking tour of Prešov before dinner. Overnight Prešov. (B, L, D)

¹ Thursday, June 24, Day 7: PREŠOV – BARDEJOV – SVIDNIK

Today we drive to Bardejov, a town with fortifications dating back to 1247. Here we see the restored medieval village of ancient Bardejov which is a UNESCO World Heritage Site. We visit the Rusyn Icon Museum featuring icons from surroundings villages, painted in the uniquely Rusyn style. Stop at the main square to see the Gothic and Renaissance Town Hall that was built between 1505-1509 to see St. Egidius Church. After lunch, we continue to Svidnik, the center of Rusyn culture in Slovakia. Upon arrival, we visit the spectacular Svidnik Museum loaded with costumes, folk art, and the history of the people in the Carpathian region. Ancient icons, church manuscripts, portraits of leaders, banners, housewares, and more. Continue to the village that contains a whole range of traditional architecture including homes, a school, firehouse, mill, and even a wooden church built in 1776. Return to Prešov for dinner with the folk performance provided by members of the Sarisan Ensemble. Overnight Prešov. (B, L, Special Dinner)

[†] Friday, June 25, Day 8: KOSICE – UŽHOROD

This morning we depart for Užhorod, stopping on the way in Kosice for a city tour to see the St. Elisabeth Cathedral and pedestrian zone with dancing fountains. We visit the Greek Catholic Cathedral of the Nativity of the Mother of God and have an audience with Archbishop Cyril Vasil (TBC). Continuing to Užhorod, we stop at Dormition of the Mother of God Church in Trebišov for a celebration of a Molében to the Mother of God. We cross the border and find ourselves in one of the most multicultural cities of ancient times - Užhorod. Depending on the schedule, we will begin our participation in the events celebrating the 375th Anniversary of the Union of Užhorod. Overnight in Užhorod. (B, L, D)

상Saturday, June 26, Day 9: UŽHOROD

We enjoy a sightseeing tour of Užhorod, including the castle, and see where the Union of Užhorod took place in 1646. View the Museum of Rusyn folklife and then on to the Outdoor Museum of Rusyn Folk Architecture which features traditional homes from every region of Transcarpathia. We stop to visit the sacred and historic St. Nicholas Monastery of Cerneca Hora (Monk Hill) now the home of almost 100 Orthodox nuns. The monastery church was built in the late 1700s and held a miraculous icon. Lunch will be on our own in any of the sidewalk cafes in downtown Mukachevo. There will be a brief walking tour of Mukachevo, followed by a trip to Palanok, the renowned Mukachevo castle. The view from there is incredible and the castle is filled with the local culture. We travel to Ivanovci and visit Romzsha Memorial, the site where the recently beatified Greek Catholic Bishop Theodore Romzsha was martyred. Overnight in Užhorod. (B, L, D)

් Sunday, June 27 and Monday, June 28, Day 10 and Day 11: UŽHOROD *

We join in the Procession, celebrate Divine Liturgy, and have a tour of the Wooden Churches. A visit would not be complete without a sampling of the delicious food and wine of the region. Overnight in Užhorod. (B, L, D) * The group will participate in all planned activities. Details will be worked out as they become available.

廿Tuesday, June 29, Day 12: UŽHOROD – MARIAPÓCS – BUDAPEST

Early this morning we depart for Hungary. On the way, we stop at the Shrine of Mariapóc to visit the Basilica and Shrine of the Holy Virgin. Although the original icon of the Weeping Madonna in the late Baroque Greek Catholic Church was taken by Maria Theresa to St. Stephen's Cathedral in Vienna, the replica enjoys the same, if not bigger, pilgrimage following. Overnight in Budapest. (B, L, D)

ੇ Wednesday, June 30, Day 13: BUDAPEST

The morning city tour of Budapest will acquaint us with many prominent sites. See the Royal Palace and Coronation Church, Fisherman's Bastion, Parliament Building, and Hero's Square. The balance of the day will be at leisure. For some of the best shopping, head for elegant Vaczi Street which is within walking distance from our hotel. Herendi porcelain and Hungarian Crewel embroidery are the typical souvenirs. This evening we enjoy dinner at a typical Hungarian restaurant with gypsy music. Overnight in Budapest. (B, Special Dinner)

Thursday, July 1, Day 14: BUDAPEST- USA
