

If you have any questions or can volunteer, please contact Mary Demyan at mdemya1@verizon.net. Many hands make light work, so any help will be much appreciated. Please mark your calendar with the following festival dates/times:

Friday, October 6<sup>th</sup>, 12 noon - cabbage preparation (boil and remove spine on cabbage leaves)
Saturday, October 7<sup>th</sup>, 9am – make balls, roll the balls in cabbage leaves, cook, and freeze Holupki
Wednesday, November 15<sup>th</sup>, 9am – make and package Kolachi
Friday, November 17<sup>th</sup>, 9am – set-up for festival (including peeling and cubing potatoes)
Saturday, November 18<sup>th</sup>, 10am – 2pm – festival (we will also need help in cleaning up afterwards)

**ANTIDORAN:** The bread that is placed on the Tetrapod, after Divine Liturgy, is the Antidoran ("instead of the gifts"). This is the bread from the Prosphora that is blessed during the preparation of the gifts, but is not used for Liturgy. Traditionally, it was given to people who were not able to receive Communion. If you know someone who is unable to receive for whatever reason, please take them some.

**BYZANTINE ICON PAINTING WORKSHOP:** Patronage Church is having a Byzantine Icon Painting Workshop with Iconographer Wayne Hajos. Wayne painted many of our icons in our church and this is an excellent opportunity for spiritual growth in our faith!

The class will be held Saturday February 3rd/10th from 9am - 5pm and Sunday February 4th/11th from 11:30am - 7:30pm. The class fee will be \$250 with all supplies included.

No art experience is necessary, and we will paint an icon of our church's patron the Theotokos.
