"ASK THE DEACON" – THIS WEEK'S QUESTION: "Can you explain what the Philip's Fast is in the Byzantine Catholic Church, Nov 15th – Dec 24th?"

ANSWER: This is the Byzantine Nativity Fast. It is called Philip's Fast since it traditionally begins on the day following November 14th, the Feast of St. Philip the Apostle. This is a period of abstinence and penance, practiced by the Orthodox and Byzantine Catholic Churches, in preparation for the Nativity of Jesus on December 25th. Just as the duration of the Great Fast (Lent) before Pascha (Easter) is 40 days, the duration of the Nativity/Philip's fast is 40 days also.
