## Byzantine Catholic Eparchy of Passaic Fasting Regulations for the Great Fast 2020 Abstinence:

- The law of Abstinence forbids the use of meat, permitting the use of eggs and dairy products.
- All the faithful of the Eparchy who receive Holy Communion are obliged to abstain
- Abstinence is to be observed on all *Wednesdays* and *Fridays* during the Holy Season of the Great Fast.

## **Strict Abstinence:**

- The law of Strict Abstinence (Fast) forbids the use of meat, eggs, and diary products.
- All the *adult* faithful of the Eparchy who receive Holy Communion are obliged to observe Strict Abstinence.
- Strict Abstinence is to be observed on the First Day of the Great Fast, Pure Monday, February 24th, and on Great and Holy Friday, April 10th.

These are just the minimum regulations. The faithful are encouraged to go beyond these minimums to the best of their abilities.
