ASK THE DEACON" – **THIS WEEK'S QUESTION**: What does the deacon say while he incenses the church?

ANSWER: After the priest, and then the deacon, incense the gifts at the Preparation Table, they proceed to the Holy Table, which the deacon incenses all around saying: *In the tomb bodily, in Hades with the soul as God, in Paradise with the thief, and on the throne You were, O Christ, with the Father and the Spirit, filling all things, the Uncircumscribed One.* The deacon then prays "the most famous of the seven Penitential Psalms," Psalm 50(51), as he incenses the apsidal icon (center, behind the Holy Table) and other icons, the iconostasis, the whole church in the customary way and the people. Psalm 50 (in some bibles it is numbered 51) begins: *Have mercy on me, O God, in your goodness; in your abundant compassion blot out my offense. Wash away all my guilt; from my sin cleanse me The deacon also recites Psalm 50 when he incenses in the same manner when the people sing the Cherubic Hymn.*
