"ASK THE DEACON" – THIS WEEK'S QUESTION: What is the feast of the Exaltation of the Holy Cross and why is it on September 14th?

ANSWER: The feast of the Exaltation of the Precious and Life-creating Cross commemorates the finding of the True Cross in 326 by Saint Helena, the mother of the Roman Emperor Constantine the Great, the dedication of churches built by Constantine on the site of the Holy Sepulcher and Mount Calvary and the recovery of the cross from the Persians in 628. It is one of the Twelve Great Feasts of the Byzantine Church and is observed as a penitential day of fasting and prayer. The Feast of the Exaltation has a one-day forefeast and is then commemorated for eight days. It was on September 14, 335, that the True Cross was first presented for veneration after the dedication of the Church of the Holy Sepulcher.
